In addition to this proof of eligibility, all applicants must fill out our camp registration forms and if accepted, all associated safety and health forms.

FAQ:

- What does the camp scholarship include?

This scholarship covers the full cost of Conservation Guardian's Summer Camp for eligible applicants ages 7 to 12, to attend a week of Conservation Guardians Summer Camp, Camp T-shirt, cap, and snack.

- How many scholarships can I apply for?

You can apply for <u>one</u> scholarship per child.

- Is my child guaranteed enrollment into camp?

No, as we have limited space in our camp, not all applicants will be awarded a scholarship. Scholarships will be awarded randomly from our pool of applicants.

- What does the scholarship not include?

We cannot provide transportation to EPCC Valle Verde Campus, or pick up from this location. Parents/guardians are required to seek out transportation as there will be no late or early morning care provided. <u>We do not</u> provide lunch for the camp, please pack a sack lunch for your child for each day of the camp except for Fridays where we will provide a pizza lunch.
